### GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION:

- It can be individual or group research projects but only one author can present and the same will receive the participant certificate.
- Submission of abstract is suffice. It shall be adhered to IMRaD format.
- Do restrict to MS word format: Times New Roman, Size 12, Space1.5, and Word Length 500.
- Do attach declaration letter stating the work is original and not presented/published anywhere. Plagiarism report is mandatory.
- Authors can submit their abstracts through an email attachment to **cconwebinar@gmail.com ONLY**.
- Abstract received after the said date of submission (05.09.2025) shall **NOT** be entertained.
- The review committee selects a maximum of 15 papers for presentation after the scrutiny.



### GUIDELINES FOR POSTER COMPETITION

- Registration is mandatory.
- Poster shall be the research projects related to the theme may be submitted.
- It can be individual or group research projects but only one author will receive participant certificate.
- Poster shall be adhered to IMRaD format.
- Poster shall be in one page in portrait orientation in PDF format size less than 5 MB.
- Font size to be 16 or greater.
- Do not reveal your personal identity on the poster.
- Do attach declaration letter stating that the work is original and not presented / published anywhere. Plagiarism report is mandatory.
- Authors can submit their poster through an email attachment to **cconwebinar@gmail.com ONLY**.
- All the poster submission shall be accepted but **NOT** after the said date of submission. (10.09.2025)



### REELS COMPETITION:

- Registration is mandatory
- Reels should be related to one of the following topics: Reliability, Validity, Primary sources of literature review, Simple random sampling and Interview method of data collection.
- Single entry is **ONLY** allowed.
- The maximum duration of time shall be 60 seconds.
- Reels file can be in MP4 format and the video should be made vertically and **NOT** horizontally.
- The resolution must be 1080p HD pixels for the sake of clarity and precise judgment.
- Reels must be original, inspired by existing trends online, and free from copyright issues.
- Reels should **ONLY** be in English and should **NOT** contain offensive, name-calling, derogatory remarks, or regional slang.
- Participants shall grant the organizers the non-exclusive right to screen their reel on their websites, social media, and other screenings
- Reels can be submitted **ONLY** to this email **cconeventscu@gmail.com**
- After the said date of submission (10.09.2025) shall **NOT** be entertained.
